Past Events

Other divers present were Paul Green, Ted Hotz and Dan LO.

The non-point dive was on Sunday, the 17th. There were four divers who left from the Yacht Club on Angelo's boat. They did two dives. The first dive was at the City of Salisbury and the second dive was at Graves Light The four divers, Angelo Correnti, Tom Lo, Todd Alger and Marshall Reynard had a great day with an abundant lobster catch. Upcoming Events

As we move into November, we also move back onshore. The point dive for November is on Sunday, November 14th, and will be at Marblehead Light. This site has provided divers with a good scallop feed on past visits. To get to the light from the South Shore you will take the Southeast X-Way to Boston. After you pass the Frontage Rd. exit you come to the exit for the airport and Mass Pike. Take the exit to go to the airport, you will see the sign with the airplane, and once you get to East Boston you will pick up signs indicating Rte. 1A. Get on Rte. 1A and you will go thru Revere, Lynn and into Swampscott. In Swampscott you will pass a shopping center. You will pass the Marshall's store and come to a Mobil station on your right. Here you turn right onto Tedesco Street. Continuing on Tedesco Street you will pass a golf course on your right. At the next traffic light, Tedesco Street becomes Humphrey Street. Continue on Humphrey Street. At the next light, Humphrey Street becomes Pleasent Street. Continue on Pleasent Street to the second traffic light. There will be a fire station at this light. Turn right. You are now on Ocean Street. Follow Ocean Street across the penninsula and continue on and you will come to Chandler Hovey Park, the location of Marblehead Light. If you go via Rte. 128, you get off at exit 25B. Get onto Rte. 114 and follow about six miles into Marblehead and get on Pleasent Street and onto Ocean Street and proceed as above. These directions were furnished by the Marblehead Police Dept.

The non-point dive is Sunday, November 21, 2004. at the Glades in Scituate. Prior to the dive, breakfast, at 8:00 a.m., and meeting for the dive, will be at the Gannett Grill in North Scituate. Directions to the Glades are as follows. If you are coming from the Quincy area you will take Rte. 3A and follow 3A into Scituate. At the large sign "Welcome to Scituate" turn left. Follow the road thru the first set of lights and you will come to the Gannett Grill on your

left. Stop and meet the rest of the group. If you are coming from the North on the highway, take Rte. 3 South. Take exit 14 off the highway. At the end of the exit turn left. You will be on Rte. 228. Follow Rte. 228 to Rte. 3A. Take Rte. 3A until you come to the "Welcome to Scituate". Turn right and pass thru the first set of lights. You will come to the Gannett Grill on your left . Meet here. If you are coming up the highway (Rte. 3) from the South, get off at exit 12. At the end of the exit take Rte.139 toward Marshfield. Follow Rte. 139 to Rte. 3A. Turn left on Rte.3A. Follow Rte. 3A until you come to the "Welcome to Scituate" sign. Turn right and proceed thru the first set of lights and you will come to the Gannett Grill on your left.Meet here.




