In Memory Bruce Gerhard March 24, 1930 -- April 3, 2007

Bruce Gerhard, formally F. Bruce Gerhard Jr., a man we thought would be our forever secretary and club parliamentarian passed away on April 3rd after a long struggle with cancer. On this night we had a regular club meeting and we made mention that Bruce had been moved from

Brigham & Womens Hospital in Boston. The next evening we learned of his passing. He had died at the Youville Hospital in Cambridge where he had been transferred. He was 77 years of age.

There is no doubt that anyone who had a contact with him will forget him. Bruce was born in Trenton, N.J. He attended Philips Academy and Harvard University. He received his doctorate in crystallography from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute. He served in the Army during the Korean War.

Bruce was a computer chip designer and worked in design and implementation for GTE, NEC and Epson.

We all knew Bruce as an avid SCUBA diver, but he was also a member of the Amateur Telescope Makers of Boston and the South Shore Astronomical Society. He was a member of Sharon Fish and Game and enjoyed skiing, Jogging and mountain climbing.

Bruce was married to the late Sylvia Gerhard and they had one son, Christopher, and two grand children, who many of you probably met at one time or another at a club function.
