#### LAST MONTH'S EVENTS

#### **Bay State Council Meeting**

The first Bay State Council meeting of the 2009 dive season was held at the South Shore Neptunes clubhouse on Wednesday February 11<sup>th</sup>.

BSC President Angelo Correnti released the BSC Meeting Schedule for the 2009 diving season. The annual BSC Board of Directors Meeting will be held on March 13<sup>th</sup> at 7:30pm. Attendance at this meeting is closed to BSC Officers and Board Members only. A special Diving Industry Meeting will be held on April 29<sup>th</sup> at 7:30pm. The purpose of this meeting is to bring dive shop owners, dive clubs and the general diving public together to develop a plan for revitalizing sport diving in Massachusetts. Attendance at this meeting is open to all dive shop owners, officers of all dive clubs and members of the general diving public. General BSC Meetings will be held on June 10<sup>th</sup>, September 9<sup>th</sup> and on December 9<sup>th</sup> at 7:30pm. Attendance at these general meetings is open to the diving community.

Progress on the Dive Flag Recognition Program was reported by Al Bozza, Vice President of the BSC and representative for the New England Aquarium Dive Club. The council is exploring the feasibility of posting Dive Flag Recognition signs at critical locations across the state. These signs will be geared toward educating both the diving and the boating publics about what the dive flag means and what the Massachusetts Dive Flag Regulations are. Al presented a prototype of what the sign might look like, and reported that he is still researching the production costs.

The Council is again encouraging member clubs to schedule more interclub dive and non-dive related activities for the 2009 dive season. Member clubs represented at the meeting all agreed that this is still the best way to keep clubs active and working together for the good of the sport. Toward this end, the representatives of the member clubs in attendance agreed to make their activities calendars available to other member clubs, and agreed that efforts will be made to invite other clubs to join them in as many of their activities as is practical.
