We learned that Stellwagen is celebrating its 20 anniversary this year. Did you know that there are 842 square miles ("the size of RI) with depths ranging from 65'-600' in the Sanctuary? Or that there is 126 square miles of diving less than 130' (at low tide)? The best time to dive is at slack tide and during the months when the tidal exchange is small. There are tough currents out there and a lot of the area is where international vessels travel and we need to fly **both** the diver's down flag as well as the **alpha** flag. BTW: the tide at the Sanctuary is 30 minutes before that of Boston Light. A lesser known fact was brought to light... Shipwrecks in the Great Lakes (discovered/undiscovered, known/unknown) are the

WALKER, Annie Alma (Reames) 96, entered life eternal at South Shore Hospital, Sunday, Feb. 26, 2012. She was born at Georgetown, S.C., and had been a longtime resident of East Weymouth before moving to South Weymouth. In 1938, she graduated from Coker College in Hartsville, S.C. In earlier years, she had taught at Hemingway, S.C., and at Myrtle Beach, S.C., in elementary schools. She was the oldest member of the Congregational Church of East Weymouth, where she had been active in the thrift shop until recently and where she had been a Sunday school teacher and a member of the choir. She joined the church in 1954 and was currently the treasurer of the Senior Club at the church. She was a former member of the Weymouth Senior Citizens. Alma belonged to Images, a group for the blind that met monthly and was sponsored by Elder Services of Weymouth. In earlier years, she had been an assembler for the Pyrotech Fire Alarm Company and had also been a bookkeeper for Bridsons Garage and Taber Motors in Weymouth. Alma was the beloved wife of the late William S. Walker, who died in 1959. She was the devoted mother of William M. Walker and his wife Marlene A. Walker of South Weymouth, Robert H. Walker, husband of the late Linda Walker, of South Weymouth, and the late Richard Walker, who is survived by his wife, Lynn Walker of East Weymouth.
