Below are the suggestions submitted by Angelo, along with a few ideas from the board. The idea here is to get your interest and your ideas added to any program put together to be reviewed by the general membership. Junior membership has to be accepted by the majority. If you have ideas, put them in writing and submit them to the secretary. Mail them in or bring them to a meeting.

Suggested

- 1. Age: 12 years through 17 years.
- 2. No junior member can hold office or be a member of the Board of Directors.
- 3. Junior Members can only attend meetings accompanied by an adult.
- 4. Junior members cannot vote on monetary decisions.
- 5. Junior members must be accompanied by an adult at all club dives.
- 6. Junior members must abide with all club rules and by-laws.
- 7. Dues for junior members who are part of a family membership to be \$20.00. If not part of a family membershipthey will be \$30.00.
- 8. All junior members must pass a board and club vote.
- Added at Board.
- 9. Junior membership years will not count towards life membership.
- 10. Club competitions would be open to junior members.
- 11. Junior membership would not require dive certification.
- 12. Junior members would be allowed to participate in meetings.
