Had an absolute blast on a one-tank dive with the incredible South Shore Neptunes Calvin Stephenson, Paul Morgan, Evan Bodel, and Chuck Zarba as the beach master at Back River/Bare Cove, Hingham, MA, on 11 November 2023. Entering the water and wapping 45 degrees with about 4 feet of visibility at 23 ft.

The underwater magic unfolded as we descended into the depths of the Back River, discovering the hidden wonders that this dive spot has to offer. From curious marine life to the unique underwater terrain, every moment was a reminder of the beauty that lies beneath the surface. We did get some visitors while we were under the surface.
